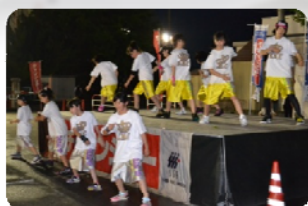
World Challenge Day

MINEPS V

The 5th International Conference of Ministers and Seniors Officials Responsible for Physical Education and Sport (MINEPS V), organized by the German Federal Ministry of the Interior, in cooperation with UNESCO and supported by International Council of Sport Science and Physical Education (ICSSPE), took place from 28-30 May 2013 in Berlin, Germany and gathered more than 600 participants from 128 countries.

ASFAA President, Mr. Vong Iao Lek was privileged to attend the meeting as representative of the Macau SAR Government.

The "Berlin Declaration", adopted unanimously during the conference, reflects the conclusions and measures need to be taken on the following issues:
